X Unacceptable Items

If items have chips, cracks, stains, rips, tears, missing buttons, broken zippers, fading, odors (pet, smoke, or other), or are in need of fixing we cannot accept them.

Baby Items

- Booster seats, Breast pumps, car seats, bouncy chairs, highchairs, strollers, pack 'n play, activity chairs, certain toys etc.
- If the item is used to secure a baby, we cannot accept it.

Clothing

- Items with stains, rips, tears, missing buttons, broken zippers etc.
- Bras, lingerie, nursing bras, boxers, briefs, shapewear
- *If your items have stains, rips, tears, missing buttons, broken zippers, fading prints, we cannot accept them. Consider donating to a clothing recycling program if your items fit this description.*

Electronics

- Appliances, batteries, cell phones, computers, laptops, tablets, smartphones, monitors, printers, projectors, TVs (any kind), VCRs, DVD players, cassette tapes, stereos/stereo speakers
